When: Saturday, Jan 5. Registration/Check in will be from 9:00-9:45 with program beginning promptly at 10:00; until 3:00.

What is the Cost: The entire day is only \$10 per scout/sibling, and includes a patch, hot lunch and all activities; \$5 for adults and leaders. All participants are also asked to bring a non-perishable item for a local food bank. **All Troops and Dens or Individual Scouts MUST pre-register by submitting the registration online www.scoutingevent.com/637-19Polar**

What About Adult Leadership: Each Den must have at least two adults/parents in attendance at this event. If a scout is attending without his Pack, a parent or guardian must attend. **Lions & Tigers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.**

How to Arrive: Dress appropriately for January in Wisconsin. Dressing in layers of polypropylene (Under Armor, etc.), fleece and wool clothing is recommended. These materials "wick" body moisture away from your skin. **Dry is warmer.** Proper attire might include: Warm jacket, outdoor fall sportswear, boots, **extra socks**, gloves (more than one pair), stocking hat.
